



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INTRODUCTION

Vithalrao Vikhe Patil Foundation, headquartered in Ahmednagar, has been a cornerstone of educational advancement since its establishment in 1986. Officially registered under the Bombay Public Trust Act of 1950 on July 5, 1982, with Registration No. MAH-544/ANR/82/BPT/Act-490 (Ahmednagar), the Foundation is committed to delivering high-quality education across a diverse range of fields. The Foundation's institutions are accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), reflecting their adherence to high educational standards and continuous improvement. Additionally, the Foundation's laboratories and research facilities hold accreditation from the National Accreditation Board for Testing and Calibration Laboratories (NABL), ensuring rigorous standards in testing and calibration. The healthcare and medical institutions are accredited by the National Accreditation Board for Hospitals & Healthcare Providers (NABH), demonstrating excellence in patient care and safety. The Foundation's administrative and operational processes are ISO certified, guaranteeing adherence to international quality management standards. Through its diverse programs in Medicine, Physiotherapy, Nursing, Engineering, Technology, Pharmacy, Agriculture, and Management, the Foundation strives to contribute significantly to the educational and professional development of individuals, ultimately supporting societal growth and advancement.

Recognizing the acute shortage of medical facilities, particularly in rural areas, the Foundation took action. On August 2, 2004, it founded a Medical College in Vilad Ghat, Ahmednagar. Affiliated with the Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik, and recognized by the Medical Council of India (Superseded by the Board of Governors) in 2009, the College has since grown under the visionary leadership of Late Eknathrao Alias Balasaheb Vikhe Patil, a recipient of the Padmabhushan Award. Today, Dr. Sujay Vikhe Patil, CEO of Vithalrao Vikhe Patil Foundation, continues this legacy.

The Medical College and Hospital have emerged as a premier center for Medical Education, Training, and Research on a national scale. It is also dedicated to providing healthcare services, especially to the underprivileged. Initially catering to 100 undergraduate seats in Medicine (MBBS), the College expanded to 150 seats in 2015 and currently offers an intake capacity of 200 undergraduates along with Postgraduate Courses, Ph.D. programs, and fellowships in certain subjects.

The institution follows guidelines set by the DMER and the Government of Maharashtra to ensure fair admission processes. Its Teaching-Learning approach not only aligns with global trends but also fosters creativity, analytical skills, innovation, and empathy. Students are encouraged to participate in extracurricular activities, cultural and sports events, yoga, intercollegiate events, and research activities to facilitate holistic development.

With a distinguished faculty, the institute upholds a strong code of ethics. It actively engages in social outreach activities, operating primary Health centers and a Rural Health Training Center for undergraduate training, providing free treatment to patients. Moreover, the institute contributes to knowledge generation through research activities, boasting numerous national and international publications, copyrights, and patents.

Equipped with facilities like an e-Library, Nature Club, Wall Magazine, Sports Club, Cultural Club, Incubation Center, Research Cell, Skill Laboratory, and Medical Education Technology Unit (MEU), the institute ensures an enriching learning environment. Additionally, it boasts a Herbal Garden, Animal House, Diagnostic Laboratory, Oncology & Radiation center, Cardiac Cath Lab, Dialysis unit, Joint Replacement center, DDRC, IVF center, and plans for an Organ Donation unit.

Block I is dedicated to I MBBS and the Department of Community Medicine. It encompasses the Department of Anatomy, Department of Physiology, and Department of Biochemistry.

Block II is designated for II MBBS. It houses the Department of Forensic Medicine & Toxicology, Department of Pathology, Department of Microbiology, and the Department of Pharmacology. Additionally, it accommodates the offices of various dignitaries such as the Secretary General, Deputy Director, Technical Director, and Dean, along with administrative sections including Establishment, Accounts, and Maintenance. Moreover, Block II features the Medical Education Unit (MEU) and three lecture theaters named Charak, Shushrut, and Dhanwantari.

The Hostels:

The institute offers hostel accommodations for both students and external research scholars. There are three separate hostels each for boys (Boys, PG boys & RMO Boys) and four for girls, catering to undergraduate, postgraduate, and interns. With ample room numbers, all students are comfortably accommodated. Each hostel room comes equipped with essential amenities such as beds, study tables, chairs, cupboards, and electrical fittings including fans and tube lights. Some rooms feature attached washrooms, while others have access to common washroom facilities. Accommodation options range from single-seaters to triple-seaters.


Central facilities in each hostel include solar water heaters, R.O. purified drinking water with water coolers, recreation rooms furnished with seating arrangements, televisions, and indoor games. Additionally, each hostel has its own mess providing meals - breakfast, lunch, dinner, and snacks - at specified times. Hygiene and food quality in the mess are strictly monitored. ICT facilities such as computers, internet, and printers are available, along with uninterrupted water and electricity supply.

Residential wardens are appointed to oversee and assist students round the clock, ensuring their welfare. Additionally, a teaching faculty member serves as the rector for each hostel, further ensuring student well-being. 24/7 security and prompt maintenance services ensure a safe and comfortable living environment for all hostel residents.

Staff Quarters:

To ensure round-the-clock services to patients, the well-being of students, and campus maintenance, several faculty members including doctors from the pre, para, and clinical streams, as well as non-teaching staff, are accommodated in a total of five staff quarters. These quarters benefit from continuous water and electricity supply, along with 24/7 security and prompt maintenance services.

A notable feature is the provision of pick-up and drop services by the school bus of Vikhe Patil English Medium School, ensuring the convenience and safety of the children of residential staff. Each staff quarter is equipped with parking lots for vehicles. Additionally, each residential staff member is allocated a designated parking space to prevent inconvenience to others. Furthermore, to enhance security measures, each staff vehicle is provided with a parking sticker.

- **Auditorium:** The institute features an auditorium with ample seating capacity, ideal for hosting cultural and academic events.
- **Gardens:** The campus boasts several beautifully maintained gardens. To keep them lush and green while conserving water, treated water from the Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) is used for irrigation.
- **Children's Park:** A dedicated children's park is available on campus, promoting outdoor activities for the children of residential staff.

- **General Stores:** The campus has general stores offering groceries, cosmetics, stationery, bakery items, and an optical store providing various spectacles and lenses as needed.
- **Bank:** An extension counter of "Pravara Cooperative Bank" is available on campus to facilitate financial transactions.
- **ATM:** The campus is equipped with an ATM provided by SVC Bank for convenient access to banking services.
- **Bus Transportation:** A bus facility within the campus serves city buses, providing essential transportation for residents, particularly benefiting those in the hilly and rural areas of Ahmednagar district.
- **Grooming Facilities:** Beauty parlors and salons are available on campus for grooming services.

- **Laundry Services:** Laundry facilities are offered to all campus residents, including students and staff.
- **Postal Services:** Dedicated staff manage postal services, ensuring convenient handling of couriers to and from the local post office for students and staff.
- **Medical Book Store:** A medical bookstore is conveniently located on campus, providing easy access to required textbooks for students.
- **Temples:** The campus houses temples dedicated to deities such as Shri Ganesh, Shri Saibaba, and Shri Dattaguru, offering spiritual spaces for residents.
- **Parking Lots:** Designated parking areas are provided for hospital staff, visitors, college staff, students, staff quarters, and hostel residents.
- **Security Services:** The campus is secured 24/7, with security personnel stationed at key locations, including the main gate, hospital, college, hostels, and staff quarters.
- **Illumination:** The entire campus is well-lit with street lights, ensuring safety and visibility throughout.
- **Solar Energy Plant:** A power generation facility that harnesses sunlight using photovoltaic panels or solar thermal systems to produce clean, renewable electricity.

- **Sewage Treatment Plant:** A facility designed to treat and remove contaminants from wastewater, ensuring that the discharged water meets environmental standards before being released back into the environment.
- **Effluent Treatment Plant:** A specialized facility for treating industrial wastewater, removing harmful chemicals and pollutants to prevent environmental contamination and ensure safe discharge or reuse.
- **Compost plant:** This facility efficiently converts organic waste into nutrient-rich compost, promoting sustainable waste management and soil enrichment on campus.





Currently the institute offers the intake capacity of 200 seats per academic year. The intake capacity of 200 includes the reserved as well as unreserved seats. Admissions under the constitutional reservation seats are governed by the Maharashtra Schedule Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Denotified Tribes, (Vimukta Jati), Nomadic Tribes, Other Backward Class and Special Backward Category (regulation of issuance and verification of) Caste Certificate Act 2000. 


