### **Department Introduction:**

The Department of Ophthalmology is located on ground floor. There are 30 beds operating as a single unit, headed by a professor.

The Department is taking all the measures to control blindness in the community under National Programme for Control of Blindness (NPCB).

Commonest being vision correction by prescription of spectacles and vision restoration by performing cataract surgeries (Phaco & SICS) with implantation of intraocular lenses. The Department has state of art equipment for diagnosis and treatment of ophthalmic disorders.



**Services Provided by the Department:**

- **Visual acuity testing.**
- **Auto refraction by a specialized optometrist.**
- **Slit lamp examination (dilated as well as undilated).**
- **Intra ocular pressure measurement.**
- **Providing lenses free of cost to patients of lower economic strata.**
